The Wheeler Centre to host Patrick Ness, Helen Garner and Ben Shewry this November

Genre fiction, memoir writing and incisive political analysis come together in **The Wheeler Centre**'s latest events program, with appearances from bestselling fantasy author **Patrick Ness**, renowned restaurateur and chef **Ben Shewry**, incisive journalist and commentator **George Megalogenis** and national treasure **Helen Garner**.

American-British novelist **Patrick Ness** is one of the most prolific and celebrated writers in contemporary fantasy and genre fiction. With a career spanning award-winning young adult novels like *The Knife of Never Letting Go* and *A Monster Calls* to adult fiction and screenwriting, Ness continues to push the boundaries of storytelling. In a special evening at The Wheeler Centre chaired by **Amie Kaufman**, Ness will take a broad look at his varied career, from his earliest novels to his latest release, *Chronicles of a Lizard Nobody* – his first foray into middle-grade fiction.

In **Helen Garner's** much-anticipated book *The Season* she turns her keen observational eye and sharp wit to the world of suburban footy, following her grandson's team through the highs and lows of the season. The celebrated author is joined by veteran broadcaster and journalist **Leigh Sales** at The Capitol to discuss Garner's newest work, the nobility of team spirit and the role sport plays in shaping young lives.

Celebrated chef and food innovator, **Ben Shewry**, heads to Montalto to serve up insights into his innovative approach to dining over a delicious two-course menu. The owner of Melbourne institution Attica is joined by writer and editor **Erik Jensen** to discuss and digest Shewry's newest book, *Uses For Obsession*, his illustrious career and deep passion for fostering an equitable and inclusive hospitality community.

The final edition of **The Fifth Estate** for the year sees host **Sally Warhaft** joined by expert commentator and journalist **George Megalogenis** for an hour of astute political analysis. They will reflect on the year that was, Australia's current state of political affairs and look ahead to what the 2025 Australian Federal election year might mean for the Australian voter.
